## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Tournament will be conducted under the Rules of Tennis and the Tennis Europe Junior Tour Rules and Regulations. Its Code of Conduct will be in force at the event.
2. Only boys and girls born between 1st January 1995 and 31st December 1998 may compete in this tournament.
3. An entry fee of €15 for qualifying and €30 for main draw must be paid on site before playing.
4. Entries to be made on the attached form must reach Tennis Ireland on or before Monday 6th July 2009.
5. Non-Irish entries must be endorsed by the player's National Association.
6. The deadline for withdrawal without incurring any penalty is the 20th July 2009.
7. It is the responsibility of the player to find out if they have been accepted into the main or qualifying draws. Notification of acceptance can be obtained from the tournament website: [www.rushbrooktennis.ie](http://www.rushbrooktennis.ie) or by contacting the Tournament Organisers at [ecrltcc@gmail.com](mailto:ecrltcc@gmail.com).
8. Each singles match will be the best of three Tie-Break sets. Doubles matches will be two Tie-Break sets and a Match Tie-Break (10 points) in place of a third set.
9. Main Draw and Doubles matches will be played outdoors on artificial grass. In case of severe weather conditions matches will be played indoors on hardcourt (acrylic). Consolation draw matches will be played indoors. Babolat Team balls will be used.
10. If absent when called upon to play during the Tournament, a player is liable to be scratched from the draw.
11. Proper tennis attire must be worn.
12. A maximum of 32 players will be accepted in the qualifying draw. The qualifying draw will take place at at Rushbrook Lawn Tennis & Croquet Club on Saturday 1st August, after sign-in (6:00pm). Play will start from 11:00am on Sunday 2nd. 8 players will qualify to play in the main draw. Main draw size is also limited to 32 players.
13. All players MUST SIGN-IN according to times specified in previous page.
14. The main draw will take place at at Rushbrook Lawn Tennis & Croquet Club on Sunday 2nd August, after sign-in (4:00pm).
15. For the doubles events, the list of entries will close at 2pm on Monday 3rd August. The acceptance will be declared and the draw made immediately. A programme of the matches will be posted on the notice board on the previous evening.
16. Winner and runner-up prizes will be awarded for the singles and doubles.
17. In entering the tournament, a player automatically grants Tennis Europe and/or host nation the right in perpetuity to take, use and show pictures of her/him, motion or still, taken during the competition without compensation.
